Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *lencten*, which means "spring." The season is a preparation for celebrating Easter. Historically, Lent began as a period of fasting and preparation for baptism by converts and then became a time for penance by all Christians.

During the Sundays of Lent, I will be focusing the sermons on the Cross. I invite you to think and dwell on these questions: Why did Jesus die on the cross? What did his death accomplish? What real difference does the cross make in our lives, the world and our relationship with God?
